Real client contribution

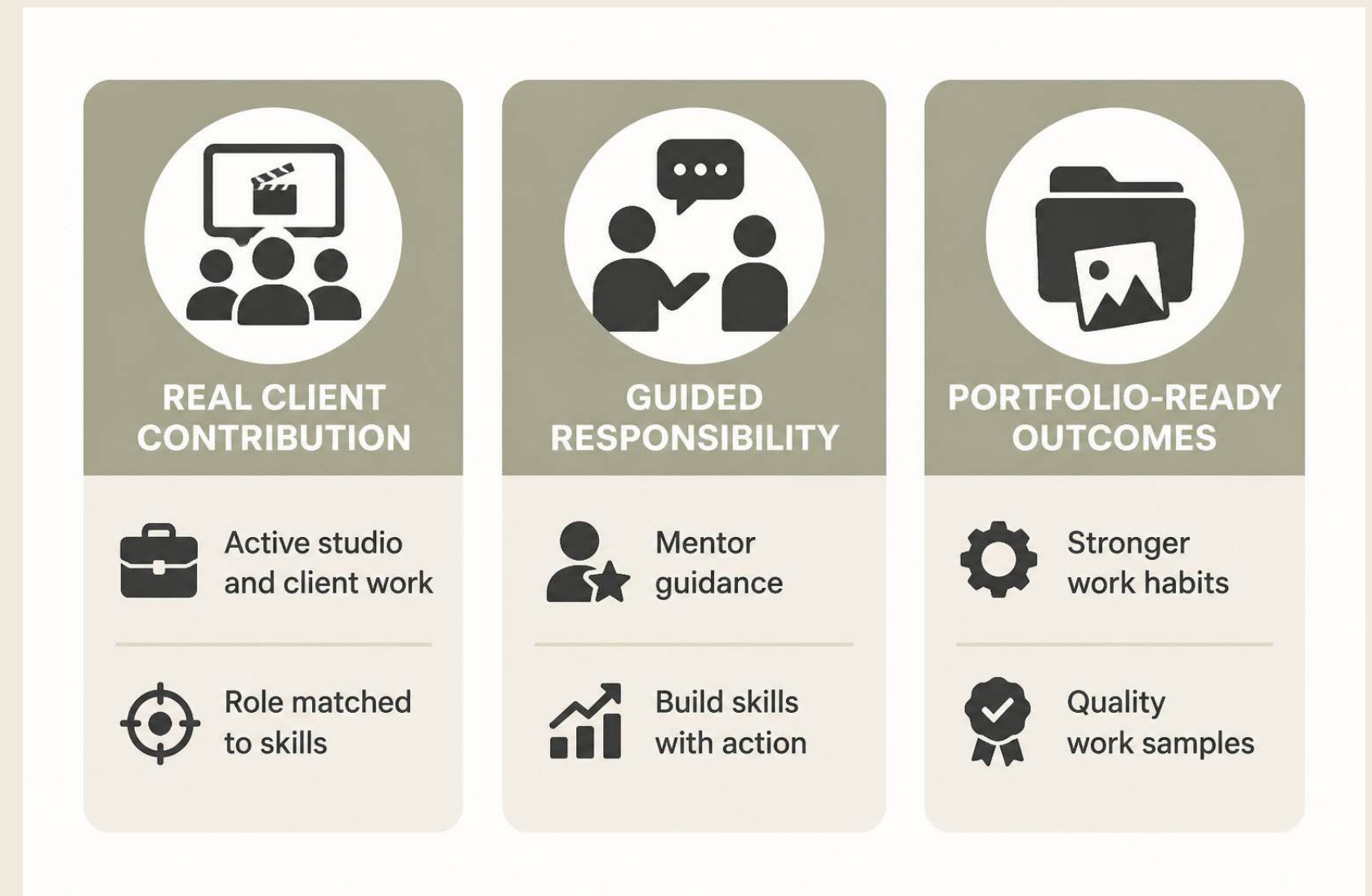
- Interns join active studio and client projects, not simulations.

How the Program Works

Semester-aligned format

- Runs **15–17 weeks**, designed to match a standard academic term.

Predictable weekly commitment

- Plan for **8–12 hours/week**, appropriate alongside classes and work.

Hybrid participation

- Work blends in-studio collaboration with remote tasks when appropriate.

Who it's for

- Open to undergraduates and recent graduates pursuing studio experience.

Academic credit-friendly

- Can support for-credit requirements when a school program allows it.

Meaningful immersion, not busywork

- Structure supports real workflow participation while staying schedule-realistic.

Growth Across the Semester

Weeks 1–2: Start Strong

- Learn studio expectations, communication norms, and professional workflow habits.
- Get oriented to the tools and setup used in real sessions.

Weeks 3–12: Build Confidence

- Shadow active work, then complete guided tasks with clear feedback.
- Take on more responsibility as skills and reliability grow.

Weeks 13–17: Show Your Work

- Own a final deliverable that demonstrates your progress and strengths.
- Finish with portfolio-ready outcomes and a wrap-up evaluation.

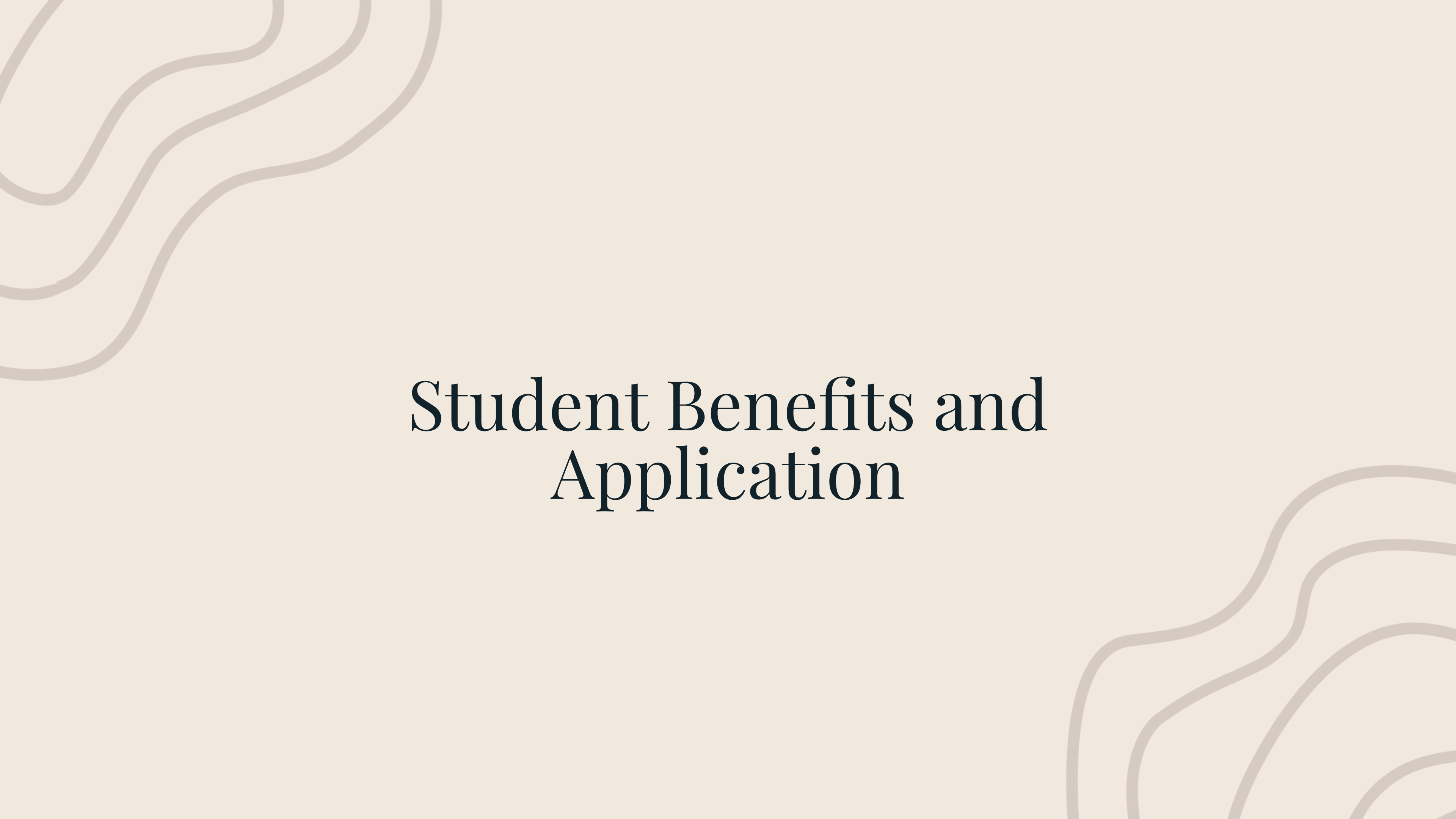
